Success Summary:

- Rudder FFA is rated gold-level in the Golden Horizon award, this is the highest state rating to be bestowed upon a Texas FFA chapter.
- Rudder FFA received the prestigious Gold Emblem rating, this is only bestowed upon the top 10 percent of FFA chapters in Texas. Gold Emblem FFA chapters advance to the national level to be judged for the National FFA Chapter Contest.
- Katherine Fazzino was named the Champion in Plant Science Division in the Texas FFA Agriscience Fair receiving a \$1,000 scholarship from the Richard Wallrath Education Foundation and advances to the National FFA Convention Competition in October in Louisville
- Also competing in the State FFA Agriscience Fair from Rudder were Myles Martinez in the Ag Power and Technology division, Alexandra Alderete in the Social Science Division, and Trenton Llewellyn in the Animal Science division.
- Jayce Wilder of the Rudder FFA Chapter was awarded the Crop Production Proficiency Award receiving a \$1,000.00 scholarship and advances to the National FFA Convention Competition in October in Louisville, Kentucky.
- Other Rudder FFA members competing in the Proficiency Award competitions were Katherine Fazzino – 2nd in Agriscience, Jayce Wilder – 2nd in Diversified Crop Production, Annie Perez – 3rd in Ag Education, Reagan Thurman – 4th in Goat

Production, Samantha Ruffino – 4th in Vet Medicine, Alexandra Alderete – 5th in Poultry Production, and Spencer Wilder – 6th in Beef Production.

- Jenna Bratton, of the Rudder FFA chapter, won the State Championship in Goat Tying at Texas FFA Rodeo Finals. Bratton was awarded a \$1,000.00 scholarship along with a trophy buckle and cash for her efforts.
